Eligibility

Participants will be provided:

- Lunch and tea/refreshments during the programme.
- Limited accommodation facilities for outstation participants on a complimentary basis, subject to availability.
- Local participants will be provided a fixed amount towards their transportation costs.
- Outstation participants will be reimbursed AC 3-tier rail fare upon submission of valid travel tickets, subject to a maximum amount as determined by IMI Bhubaneswar.

Selection Process

Applications will be screened by the Programme Committee. While applications received earlier will be given due consideration, selection will be based on the suitability of the candidate's research profile and the availability of seats. The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.
