

10th International Conference on "Global Business Environment"

BHUBANESWAR, December 24th, 2025 - The International Management Institute (IMI) Bhubaneswar, in collaboration with EGADE Business School Mexico, hosted the 10th International Conference on "Global Business Environment" on December 24-25, 2025. The theme of the conference was "International Business Diplomacy, Global Trade, and Economic Development in Developing Countries".
