POLICY DOCUMENT – SCHOLARSHIPS for PGDM 2016-18

PRE-ADMISSION SCHOLARSHIPS

Only one of the below mentioned pre-admission scholarships can be availed.

1. Merit scholarship

- Up to Rs. 1 lakh for applicants having a first-class career and securing at least 75 percentile in CAT/XAT/GMAT/CMAT.
- CAT/XAT: Merit scholarship amount for an applicant will be calculated in the following manner: Rs. 2000/- for every percentile secured above 50 percentile for candidates having a first-class career and securing at least 75 percentile in CAT/XAT.
For example, a candidate having a first-class career and securing 80 percentile in CAT will be entitled to a scholarship of Rs. 60,000/- (30 percentile x Rs. 2000 per percentile).
- GMAT: Merit scholarship amount for an applicant will be calculated in the following manner: Rs. 2000/- for every percent secured above 50 percent for candidates having a first-class career and securing at least 75 percent in GMAT.
For example, a candidate having a first-class career and securing 80 percent in GMAT will be entitled to a scholarship of Rs. 60,000/- (30 percent x Rs. 2000 per percent).
- CMAT: Merit scholarship amount for an applicant will be calculated in the following manner: Rs. 2000/- for every percentile secured above 70 percentile for candidates having a first-class career and securing at least 75 percentile in CMAT.
For example, a candidate having a first-class career and securing 90 percentile in CMAT will be entitled to a scholarship of Rs. 40,000/- (20 percentile x Rs. 2000 per percentile).
- 50% of the scholarship amount would be disbursed during Trimester III of the academic year and the rest 50% in Trimester VI of the academic year.

2. Merit scholarship for women candidates

- 20% additional merit scholarship for female applicants fulfilling the above-mentioned merit scholarship criteria.

For example, a female candidate having a first-class career and securing 80 percentile in CAT will be entitled to a scholarship of Rs. 72,000/- [(30 percentile x Rs. 2000 per percentile) + 20% of (30 percentile x Rs. 2000 per percentile) = Rs. 72,000/-].

- 50 % of the scholarship amount would be disbursed during Trimester III of the academic year and the rest 50% in Trimester VI of the academic year.


3. Wards of defence and paramilitary personnel


- Wards of defence personnel are eligible for a scholarship of Rs. 50,000.
- 50 % of the scholarship amount would be disbursed during Trimester III of the academic year and the rest 50% in Trimester VI of the academic year.

4. Sportspersons

- Scholarship of Rs. 1 lakh for applicant who has represented India at a senior level and played in an international competition conducted by the authorized sports body approved by the Ministry of Sports, Government of India.
- Scholarship of Rs. 50,000 for applicant who has represented the state at a senior level and played in a national competition conducted by the authorized sports body.
- 50 % of the scholarship amount would be disbursed during Trimester III of the academic year and the rest 50% in Trimester VI of the academic year.
