ODISHA STARTUP POLICY-2016

Resolution No.5670/MSME MSME (G&M)-188/2016 Dated the 29th August, 2016



1. Preamble

Government of Odisha plans to create conducive environment for Startups, empower Startups to grow through innovation and design, create a worldclass scientific ecosystem and enable its youth to pursue their dreams within the State.

This Startup policy shall act as a catalyst in the economic growth of Odisha creating models for scalability and replicability across the State resulting in large scale employment opportunities.



2. Vision

- To emerge amongst the top 3
 "Startup Hubs" in India by 2020
 through strategic partnerships,
 conducive ecosystem, investment
 and policy interventions.
- To unleash the potential of women entrepreneurship in Odisha by encouraging at least 33% of the Startups with Founders/Co-Founders as women.

3. Mission

- a) Build a holistic Startup ecosystem in Odisha to enable the State to become one of the top three Startup destinations in the country
- b) Provide fiscal and non-fiscal benefits in a transparent and time bound manner
- c) Streamline rules, regulations and legislations to create a Startup friendly environment
- d) Implement a supportive regulatory framework and robust governance structure that enables hassle-free, time bound statutory clearances and monitoring of this policy

4. Objectives

- a) Develop a world class "Startup Hub" in Odisha by 2020;
- Encourage incubators including sector specific ones aligning with the State's strengths and requirements;
- c) Create enabling environment and supporting eco-system that facilitates at least 1,000 Startups in next five years in the State;
- d) Take steps to provide skill-based training to encourage youth to take up Startups;
- e) Encourage all major companies operating out of Odisha to include skill and infrastructure development for Startups as an integral component of their CSR activities;
- f) Create a strong institutional framework for effective implementation, monitoring and evaluation of this policy.



5. Scope

The policy would provide incentives and exemptions over and above the Startup policy of Government of India and any other existing policy in the State.

6. Policy period

The Odisha Startup policy will remain in operation for a period of five years from the date of its notification or until substituted by another policy, whichever is earlier.



7. Definitions

- (i) Accelerator: Accelerator is an organization or program that enables rapid growth of new Startups by providing specific services like: mentoring, training, resources and networking to help Startups increase their customer base, generate more profits, prepare for funding and professionalize their organization.
- (ii) Entity: Private Limited Company or One Person Company (as per the Companies Act 2013), a Registered Partnership Firm (under the Partnership Act, 1932) or Limited Liability Partnership (under the Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008).

(Note: ammended vide Notification No.2014/MSME Bhubaneswar Dated the 31st March, 2017, MSME (G&M)-06/2017(Pt.))

(iii) Incubator: An organization designed to support Startup companies during the early stages to help develop a scalable business model through business support resources and services such as physical space, capital, coaching and mentoring, common services including corporate and legal services and providing networking connections. An Incubator shall also mean a Technology Business Incubator (TBI) recognized either by the Central or State Government.

The incubator entity must be a registered entity falling under any one of the following categories:

- a) Society (under The Societies Registration Act, 1860)
- b) Section 8 Company (under The Companies Act, 2013)
- c) Private Limited Company (under The Companies Act, 2013)
- d) Public Company (under The Companies Act, 2013)
- e) Limited Liability Partnership (under The Limited Liability Partnership Act, 2008)

The incubator entity should facilitate at least 3 months interaction in person or virtual between its incubatees and mentors, when in operation.

Besides the above, Startup Council may consider case of a reputed academic institution/university / deemed university for recognition as incubator even if the same does not fall under any of the above categories.

(iv) Innovation: The process of translating an idea or invention into a good or service that creates value for which customers will pay. Innovation involves deliberate

application of information, imagination and initiative in deriving greater or different values from resources.

(v) **Nodal Agency:** Nodal Agency shall mean reputed Government as well as other institutions / organizations as approved by the Startup Council as Nodal Agencies for certifying Startups.

(vi) **Startup**: Startup is an entity involved in crafting repeatable and scalable product or service making a positive impact in the society, where the solution is not obvious and success is not guaranteed.

An entity shall be considered as a "Startup" provided that:

a) The date of its incorporation / registration is not prior to 7 years. In case of Biotechnology Startups incorporation/ registration should not be prior to 10 years.

- b) Its annual turnover does not exceed Rs. 25 crore, for any preceding financial year;
- c) Such entity is working towards innovation, development,

deployment or commercialization of new products, processes or services driven by technology or intellectual property and makes it scalable for achieving commercial success;

- d) It is registered in Odisha or employs at least 50 percent of its total qualified workforce in Odisha;
- e) Such entity is not an extension of the existing family business; or formed by splitting up or reconstruction of a business already in existence.
- (vii) **Successful Startup:** Successful Startup: Startup would be considered 'successful' if it fulfils any of the following conditions:
- Startup has got total equity financing by SEBI registered AIF (Alternative Investment Fund) Category 1 & 2 fund or Angel Networks of at least INR 25 Lakh; or
- 2. Sanction Letter of funding / grant by Government of India or any State Government of at least INR 5 Lakh; or
- 3. The startup has got a revenue run rate of at least INR 10 Lakh a month over previous six months.

- (viii) Marketing expense: Expense of the following nature shall be considered as marketing expense:
 - Media purchase to promote startup product / service across digital, print, TV, radio and Out of Home media; or
 - 2. Expense for media development such as creative, jingles, brochures, etc. as may be required; or
 - 3. Cost for setting up stall or counter at a business relevant exhibition in India or abroad along with economy class travel and three star hotel stay for the duration of the event for two individuals working with the Startup for at least three months subject to prior approval of the Government. Sales discount shall not form part of the marketing expense.

8. Startup Ecosystem

The Government of Odisha recognizes the fact that the seeds of entrepreneurship and the instinctive ability to innovate must be nurtured through an enabling ecosystem, such as:

- Creation of world class physical infrastructure to support Startups;
- Promoting the culture of innovation through Academic Interventions;
- Institutionalizing the culture of entrepreneurship by providing training for the requisite Skills

8.1. Infrastructure : Germinating Startups through Incubators

Realizing the importance of quality infrastructure required for creating successful Startups, government would encourage creating world class incubators in:

- University/Institutions, where fresh minds sprout new ideas;
- R&D/Incubators, where innovation is encouraged through a structured approach; and
- Industry/place of work, where new challenges and opportunities lead to innovation.

8.1.1. University / Institution

The State will encourage Universities / Educational Institutions, which are in existence for at least 5 years and approved by State Level Implementation Committee to be eligible to support and mentor innovators. These institutions can utilize the existing facilities or set up

new Incubators to create a Startup ecosystem.

Such approved institutions will be eligible for a one time grant of 50% of capital cost (excluding the cost of building) upto a maximum of Rs 1 crore to set up / scale up an Incubator Facility.

In case a University recognized under the Central/State Act / a reputed academic institution/ Centre of Excellence such as IIT, IIM, NISER, IISER etc. is able to raise funding for development of its incubation infrastructure, the Startup Council may consider providing a matching grant subject to an upper limit of Rs.5 crore on case to case basis. Such grant from the government shall only be used for development of incubation of infrastructure including purchase of equipment for the incubation facility.

These approved institutions shall be eligible for performance capital grant of Rs. 5 lakh for each successful Startup (as per the definition) that they incubate for a minimum period of three months.

Reputed Government institutions in the State may be approved by the State Level Implementation Committee as Nodal Agencies for certifying Startups for the purpose of applicability of this policy. The State Level Implementation Committee may allow any other institution to be a nodal agency on a case to case basis.

8.1.2. Incubators

The State will encourage incubators recognized either by the Central or State Government and approved by State Level Implementation Committee to be eligible to support and mentor Startups. Such approved incubators shall be eligible for assistance for mentoring service.

The approved incubators shall be eligible for a performance capital grant of Rs. 5 lakh for each successful Startup they incubate.

8.1.3. Industry groups / Industry House

The State will encourage existing Industrial groups in existence for at least 5 years in the State to support the Startup / Innovation drive. The Industry can utilize their existing facility or set up new Incubators to create Startup ecosystem. The Industry group shall be approved by the State Level Implementation Committee to be eligible to support and mentor Startups. Such Industry group shall be eligible for assistance for mentoring service.

These approved Industry groups/houses shall be eligible for a performance capital grant of Rs. 5 lakh for each successful Startup that they create.

8.1.4. Startup / Innovation Park

The Government would establish one or more Startup / Innovation Park in the State as one-stop-destination for Startups, either on its own or in partnership with private sector.

The Startup / Innovation park shall have necessary common facilities and support infrastructure, such as:

- a) Common Testing labs, Design Studio & Tool Rooms
- b) Shared support services for Startups such as legal, accounting, technology, patents and banking services
- c) Community Events and Promotional support for incubators and Startups
- d) Enterprise Software and shared Hardware

The CSR Funds of State PSUs shall also be channelized and utilized for the development of Startup / Innovation Park in compliance with the Companies Act 2013.

8.1.5. Institution - Incubator - Industry Partnership (3i)

A "Three-I" (3i) platform shall be created where institutions, incubators and industry shall be networked through an e-platform.

This platform shall function as a "Virtual Incubator" to Startups connecting the research institutes, mentors, Startups and other stakeholders. The platform shall also provide access to Government empanelled service providers in areas such as Law, Finance, Accountancy, Marketing, etc.

8.1.6. Sector Specific Incubators

Sector-specific incubators shall be encouraged in areas such as IT/ITEs, ESDM, Healthcare and Sanitation, Agri Business and Food Processing, Hi-Tech farming, Tourism, Textiles and Garments, Chemical and Petrochemicals, Downstream and Ancillary.

These incubators shall be setup by the concerned Government Departments, either on their own or in partnership with private sector.

8.1.7. Incubator Franchise - Challenge Model

In order to build world class incubators, the Government shall identify Business Incubators, by selecting an Incubator Franchise through an international competitive bidding process as approved by the Government.

The competitive process shall be for local and foreign entities and shall have Venture Capitalists, Private Equity groups, Super-Angels, Local and Multi-National Corporations as their partners in the development of incubators in Odisha.

8.2. Academic Interventions

To foster a culture of entrepreneurship and build the ecosystem for Startups, the State Government shall undertake the following academic interventions in association with Industry Associations.

8.2.1. University Syllabus

The Universities shall be advised to introduce courses in Startup education and entrepreneurship development.

8.2.2. State Schools Syllabus

Inputs in Entrepreneurship and innovation shall be introduced as part of the State School Syllabus to give students an introduction to the subject and help develop tan aptitude for the same.

8.2.3. Faculty Up-gradation

The Government shall support universities to train the faculty for promotion of innovation and entrepreneurship as per the existing policy and guidelines of State Government in Higher Education Department and concerned Universities.

8.2.4. Sabbatical Scheme for College and University Faculty

A sabbatical scheme shall be introduced for College or University professors, who work along with students at an incubator, to pursue entrepreneurship for a specified period. In case any faculty decides

to join a Startup approved by the nodal agency, the faculty shall be eligible for an Extra Ordinary Leave without payment for a maximum period of 3 years.

8.3. Startup Skills Ecosystem

The below mentioned initiatives shall be taken up in association with Industry Associations, Angel Investors etc.

8.3.1. Startup Role Model Program

The Government will encourage innovation amongst the entrepreneurs and students which focus on innovative products that address societal problems.

Top 10 Startups operating in the State shall be identified through a selection process and shall be given a platform to meet and interact with mentors for getting funding support for product development and marketing. "Startup of the Year" award shall be given to top 3 shortlisted Startups from the State. Similar awards such as "Best Mentor", "Investor of the year" shall also be given through this program which would be conducted annually with the assistance of Industry Associations operating in the State.

8.3.2. Boot camps

College and School Level Startup Development Clubs (Boot camps) will be established through incubators to foster innovation and entrepreneurial spirit at the school and college levels.

8.3.3. International Startup Culture and Exchange Programme

An international Startup exchange program shall be setup to garner knowledge and experience from global startup destinations to enhance the startup culture in the State.

The Government will tie-up with the international organizations to send Startups to leading global Startup destinations for gaining international exposure. Similarly, tie-ups may be setup to bring world class Startups to work alongside Startups in Odisha for faster learning and cultural exchange.



9. Funding and Incentives

9.1. Startup Capital Infrastructure Fund

A Startup Capital Infrastructure fund/ Seed Fund upto Rs. 25 crore shall be sourced as per requirement through budgetary provision of MSME Department to support development of hard and soft infrastructure for the startup ecosystem in the State such as physical infrastructure for incubators including testing labs, design studio, tool rooms, virtual incubators etc.

9.2. Startup Seed Fund

Government may participate in the Private State specific funds for Startups to set up operations in the State, such as seed/venture capital funds, limited to 1/4th of the total size, only when there is firm commitment from the private State specific fund manager of bringing in 3/4th money to the State. The contribution would be released simultaneously when the private sector fund makes the contribution in the above ratio.

9.3. Assistance at Idea / Prototype Stage

- a) Institution / Incubator / Industry will support the innovator by providing mentor services and would allow the innovator to use facilities available in the institution / Incubator / Industry for Startups
- b) Monthly allowance of Rs.20,000 (The monthly allowance shall be Rs.22,000/-, if the startup

Founder (s)/Co-Founder (s) are Women or transgender or from Social Categories such as SC/ST/SEBC/PH. In such a case, Woman or transgender or SC/ST/SEBC/PH should have at least 50% equity in the startup entity) will be provided to a recognized Startup for a period of one year, if it fulfils any of the following conditions:

- Startup has got total equity financing by SEBI registered AIF Category 1 & 2 fund or Angel Networks in the range of at least INR 5 Lakh upto INR 1.0 crore; or
- 2) Startup has a patent filed in its company name and published in the Journal by the India Patent Office in the areas affiliated with the nature of business being promoted; or
- 3) Sanction letter of funding / grant by Government of India or any State Government (Either directly or through third party implementing partner).
- 4) The startup has got a revenue run rate between INR 50 thousand and INR 10 lakh a month over the previous three months at least.

(Note: ammended vide Notification No.2014/MSME Bhubaneswar Dated the 31st March, 2017, MSME (G&M)-06/2017(Pt.) and vide Notification MSME, Bhubaneswar dtd. 16.03.2018 No.S&I(Startup)-20/2018/1805)

c) Reimbursement of Rs.1.00 lakh per year for 3 years would be provided to Institution / Incubator / Industry for providing free internet, free electricity and mentoring services. This benefit will not be available for virtual incubators

(Note: ammended vide Notification No.2014/MSME Bhubaneswar Dated the 31st March, 2017, MSME (G&M)-06/2017(Pt.))

- d) Need-based assistance would be considered a case to case basis to a certified Startup for cost of raw material / components and other related equipment required for the innovative process for the new product development, as per the recommendation of the Startup Council/ State level Implementation Committee.
- e) Recognised startups may avail subsidy benefit to the extent of 50% of monthly rental of the incubation space (subject to a maximum of Rs. 5000) for a period of maximum one year, if getting incubated at any of the incubators recognised by the Startup Odisha Initiative.

9.4. Assistance once the Idea / Concept get commercialized

 a) Product development and Marketing/Publicity assistance up to a maximum of Rs.15 lakh (The amount shall be Rs.16 lakhs, if the startup Founder (s)/Co - Founder (s) is Woman or transgender or from Social C at e gories such as SC/ST/SEBC/PH. In such a case, Woman or transgender or SC/ST/SEBC/PH should have at least 50% equity in the startup entity) shall be given to a Startup for introduction of innovated product in the market, if it fulfils any of the following conditions:

Startup has got total equity financing by SEBI registered AIF Category 1 & 2 fund or Angel Networks of at least INR 25 Lakh; or

Sanction Letter of funding / grant by Government of India or any State Government (Either directly or through third party implementing partner) of at least INR 5 Lakh; or

The startup has got a revenue run rate of Rs.2.5 lakh per month during the preceding six months.

 VAT/CST paid in Odisha by the Startup companies shall be reimbursed as per the Industrial Policy 2015. c) The cost of filing and prosecution of patent application will be reimbursed to the Startup companies as per the Industrial Policy 2015.

9.5 Assistance for Startup Funding

The Government shall encourage banks and other financial institutions to extend and enhance their lending facilities to Startups and set up dedicated desks for Startups in select branches for easy funding.

The Government shall also encourage Angel Investors Network and various seed capital funding agencies to forge strategic partnership with industry/Startup associations in the State.

9.6. Self-Certification and Compliance Incentives

Startups shall be exempted from inspections under the following Acts and the Rules framed there under, barring inspections arising out of specific complaints. Startups will be permitted to file self-certifications, in the prescribed formats under various acts:

- a) Industrial Disputes Act, 1947
- b) Trade Unions Act, 1926
- c) Building and Other Constructions Workers' (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996.
- d) Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946.
- e) Other such laws are Inter-State Migrant Workmen (Regulation

- of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1979
- f) Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972
- g) Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, 1970
- h) Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act. 1952
- i) Employees' State Insurance Act, 1948
- j) All Labour Laws covered under the Voluntary Compliance Scheme of State Labour & ESI Department

General permission shall be available for 3-shift operations including women working in the night for Startups, subject to such units taking the prescribed precautions with respect to safety and security of employees.

9.7. Financial Support to Startups for Participating in National and International events

The Government shall provide financial support to state recognised Startups for participating in the reputed national and international events, where they are representing the state. The support may include economy class air fare or 3 tier AC train fare for travel & free space in the stall, if set up by State Government.

10. Support and Assistance

10.1. Smart Cities and AMRUT Cities

The Smart Cities and Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) cities planned by the Ministry of Urban Development, Government of India and the Government of Odisha shall earmark designated areas for development for Startups.

Specific guidelines to support this initiative shall be notified based on the framework for development of Smart cities and AMRUT cities in Odisha.

10.2 Market Access

The State shall implement specific interventions to provide market opportunities and access for the Startups registered in the State.

10.2.1 Government Procurement

- 20% of the total procurement by State Ministries/ Departments/ State PSUs shall be mandatory from Micro & Small Enterprises or Startups.
- There would not be any minimum turnover requirement for Micro and Small Enterprises in participating in public procurement process. All State Government Departments and Agencies will additionally relax condition of prior experience with respect to Startups in all public procurements subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications.

10.2.2 Training Program - Startup Festival / Innovation Week

The Government will encourage institutions and Industry Associations to organize Startup Festival / Innovation Week. Such fests would help in showcasing innovation and provide a platform for collaboration thereby connecting with investors, mentors, incubators, exhibitions, product launches, etc.

10.2.3 Tie-ups with e-commerce companies

The State Government shall explore formal tie-up with established e-commerce companies, both multiproduct and sector-specific, to provide a marketing platform for the registered Startups in the State to showcase their respective products.



11. Governance

The policy shall enable proper implementation and smooth functioning of all the provision to facilitate the Startups. The policy shall be governed by a three tier governance structure:

- a) Startup-Council
- b) Task Force based review mechanism
- Startup Secretariat at Institute of Entrepreneurship Development, Odisha (IED)

Note: State Level Implementation Committee wherever written in the policy shall be replaced by Startup Council.

11.1.Startup-council / State Level Implementation Committee

To foster innovation in the State, a Startup council shall be set up. The council shall be responsible to drive innovation, advise prospective Startups and guide the innovation eco-system. The council, based on the requirement, may form subcommittees to work in specific areas.

A council shall have the following members:

1. Chief Secretary: Chairman

2. Additional Chief : Member Secretary (Finance)

3. Principal Secretary: Member (MSME) Convener

4. Principal Secretary: Member (Industries)

5. Principal Secretary (IT): Member

6. Principal Secretary: Member (Skill Development and Technical Education)

- One Technical Expert: Invitee
 (Concerned subject) Member
- 8. Four Members from stakeholder including representatives from industry, academia, incubators and Apex Industry Associations, regional Industry Associations, training and development institutions, TiE etc.

The committee shall perform the following functions including but not limited to:

- a) Approval of Nodal Agencies.
- b) Empanelment of Mentor Institution / Incubators / Industry House. The State Level Implementation Committee may also allow collaboration with Incubators outside the State on a case-to-case basis
- c) Monitor performance through periodic review
- d) Selection of seed fund/venture fund managers and review of performance

e) Revisit the policy document and suggest modifications from time-to-time

11.2. Task Force / Review Mechanism

- a) A task force chaired by Principal Secretary (MSME) shall be set up at the State level to monitor disbursal of fiscal incentives proposed in the policy.
- b) The members of the task force shall have representatives from stakeholder agencies, institutions, representatives from industry, academia, incubators and Apex Industry Associations, regional Industry Associations, training and development institutions etc. Need based members shall be co-opted as and when required.
- c) Specific Performance Indicators (SPIs) shall be defined for monitoring the policy objectives. An online system to track the progress on policy objectives in real time will be built, ensuring transparency and accountability in the process of target monitoring and reporting.
- d) The Task Force shall periodically review the implementation process and report the progress to State Level

- Implementation Committee on a periodic basis.
- e) The Task Force shall also revisit the policy document from time to time to review and suggest recommendations to the State Level Implementation Committee to realign it as per the changing needs of the Startup business community.

11.3. Startup Development Cells

Startup Development Cells shall be established at each DIC and in identified Universities / Colleges, to provide the youth with requisite information regarding the Startup Policy and its provisions.

Each Startup Development Cell shall have a Ready Reckoner or Information Handbook on Doing Business for Startups in English, Hindi and Odia languages.

11.4. The Startup Secretariat at Institute of Entrepreneurship Development, Odisha (IED) chaired by CEO, IED shall be responsible for day to day functioning of the Startup Odisha initiative till the Mission Director, Startups take over the institution.

12. Procedure

a) Selection of Nodal Institutes will be on invite basis and approval by the Startup Council.

b) The Institute / Incubator / Industry which intend to promote the startups, will submit its proposal to Startup Secretariat online for empanelment as Mentor Institute / Incubator/Industry.

e) The startups will be required to register with Startup Odisha initiative online to avail monetary (Monthly allowance, Marketing Expense, Raw Material assistance, or any other that might be announced by the state govt.)/non monetary benefits under the policy.

The Nodal Agency on satisfaction will:

- a) certify the registration proposal online;
- b) process, certify and review application of Startups for various monetary / non monetary benefits.
 All such applications will be

forwarded online to Startup Secretariat.

Startup Secretariat will examine all such applications and present them along with their recommendation to the Task Force for final consideration / approval. Result will be emailed to the Startup directly and will also be published online.

Once approved, by the Task Force, Startup will receive the monetary benefit directly in their bank account subject to clearance by Startup Secretariat on due diligence of required documents.

h) The existing incubators can avail performance capital grant and reimbursement benefit (for free internet, electricity and mentoring service).

Aspiring / Existing incubators established in a University / Educational Institute will be eligible for one time capital grant up to INR 1.0 crore subject to recommendation of the Startup Council. To be eligible for one time

capital grant, Aspiring / Existing incubator should dedicate a minimum of 5,000 sq. feet of carpet area to the incubatees.

i) Existing / Aspiring incubator will apply for monetary benefit (performance capital grant, reimbursement benefit, one time capital grant, or any other that might be announced by the state govt.) / non monetary benefit online as applicable with the Startup Odisha initiative.

Startup Secretariat will examine all application(s) and present them along with their recommendation as follows:

- a) One Time Capital Grant application(s) will be presented to the Startup Council for final consideration/approval.
- b) All other application(s) will be presented to the Task Force for final consideration/approval.

Result will be emailed to the incubator directly and will also be published online.

Once approved, Incubator will receive the monetary benefit directly in its bank account subject to clearance by Startup Secretariat on due diligence of required documents.

i) A startup applicant can reapply for

startup recognition/ financial assistance one more time after a gap of 3 months from the date of communication of rejection.

13. General Terms and Conditions

a) Doubts relating to interpretations of any term and/or feedback on the policy or operating guideline and/or dispute relating to the operation of any of the provisions under this policy be referred to the Startup Secretariat online.

Startup Secretariat will collate all such doubts and present along with their recommendation to Task Force / Startup Council for clarification / resolution. The decision of the Task Force / Startup Council in this regard shall be final and binding on all concerned.

- b) No right or claim for any incentive under this policy shall be deemed to have been conferred merely on the ground of provision in this policy. - c) The State Government may at any time amend any provision of this policy.

OPERATIONAL GUIDELINES for ODISHA STARTUP POLICY-2016

Notification No.7098 / MSME S&I (IED)-20/2018 Dated the 6thNov, 2018 Bhubaneswar

I - Definitions

For the purpose of convenience, all definitions as per the Odisha Startup Policy-2016 and subsequent amendment in March, 2017 and 2018 are indicated in Annexure-1.

II - Startup

Startup Recognition / Registration

The registration by a startup entity for recognition can be done online by simply filling a Startup Registration Form (Annexure-2) and giving self- certification for the following set of documents:

- Incorporation certificate of the entity:
 This would be verified from the MCA-21 portal.
- 2. Self-certification for Startup definition:
 - a. The date of its incorporation / registration is not prior to 7 years. In case of Biotechnology Startups incorporation / registration should not be prior to 10 years.
 - b. The entity's annual turnover does not exceed Rs.25 crore, for any preceding financial year.
 - c. If not registered in Odisha, the entity employs at least 50% of its total qualified workforce in Odisha.
 - d. The entity is not an extension of the existing family business; or formed by splitting up or reconstruction of a business already in existence.
- 3. Self-Certification for Proof of innovation:
 - a. DIPP Startup India recognition certificate; OR
 - b. Startup has a patent filed in the entity name and published in the Journal by the India Patent Office in areas affiliated with the nature of business being promoted; OR

- c. Sanction Letter of funding / grant to the entity / founder/ Co-founder by Government of India or any State Government (Either directly or through third party implementing partner) as part of any specified scheme to promote innovation; OR
- d. Letter of funding of not less than 20 percent in equity by any Incubation Fund/ Angel Fund/ Private Equity Fund/ Accelerator/ Angel Network duly registered with Securities and Exchange Board of India that endorses innovative nature of the business; OR
- e. If an entity doesn't possess any of the above mentioned four documents, they may submit a one page write-up / note explaining innovative nature of its product. The applicant entity is encouraged to share its business plan along with the note on innovation.

Application Process for Recognition / Registration

- 1. The startup entity will have to submit its application online in the Startup Registration Form (Annexure-2).
- 2. The Nodal Agency on satisfaction will certify the registration proposal online within 2 weeks, which they will forward to the Startup Secretariat. However, Nodal Institute may schedule a call or a meeting with the startup entity, if it deems necessary, within the first week of receipt of such application.
- 3. Startup Secretariat will collate all such certified applications and will present them with its recommendation to the Task Force for consideration and final approval.

- 4. Result will be published online and also emailed to the concerned Startup entity.
- 5. In case a Nodal Agency is unable to evaluate an application within the specified time of 2 weeks, it shall be granted a maximum of additional 1week time to complete the process. In case the concerned Nodal Agency does not meet the extended deadline, the application shall automatically move to another Nodal agency with the same domain with the time limit of two weeks for disposal. In rare cases, where both the first and the second Nodal Agency fail to evaluate an application within their specified time limits, it shall automatically move to the Startup Secretariat. The Startup Secretariat shall evaluate the same within two weeks.

Benefits to Recognized Startup

A 'recognized Startup entity' may apply for any of the following monetary benefits available under the Startup Odisha initiative:

1. Monthly allowance of Rs.20,000 (the amount shall be Rs.22,000/- if the startup Founder(s)/ Co-Founder(s) are Women or Transgender or from Social Categories such as SC/ST/SEBC/PH. In such a case, woman or transgender or SC/ST/SEBC/PH should have at least 50% equity in the startup entity) which may be provided to a 'recognized Startup entity' for a period of one year, if it fulfills any of the following conditions:

- a. Startup has got total equity financing by SEBI registered AIF Category 1 & 2 fund or Angel Networks in the range of (at least) Rs. 5 Lakh to Rs. 1.00 crore; or
- b. Startup has a patent filed in the entity name and published in the Journal by the India Patent Office in areas affiliated with the nature of business being promoted; or
- c. Sanction letter of funding / grant to the entity / founder/ Co-founder by Government of India or any State Government (Either directly or through third party implementing partner); or
- d. The startup has got a revenue run rate of Rs. 50 thousand to Rs. 10 Lakh per month over the last three months at least.
- 2. Product Development and Marketing/Publicity assistance up to Rs. 15 lakh (the amount shall be Rs.16 lakhs, if the Startup Founder(s)/ Co-Founder(s) is woman or transgender or from Social categories such as SC/ST/SEBC/PH. In case, Woman or transgender or SC/ST/SEBC/PH should have at least 50% equity in the startup entity), which may be given to a 'recognized' Startup entity for introduction of innovated product in the market, if it fulfills any of the following conditions:
 - a. Startup has got total equity financing by SEBI registered AIF Category 1 & 2 fund or Angel Networks of at least Rs. 25 Lakh; or
 - b. Sanction Letter of funding / grant to the entity / founder/ Co-founder by Government of India or any State Government (Either directly or through third party implementing partner) of at least Rs. 5 Lakh; or

- c. The startup has got a revenue run rate of Rs.2.5 lakh per month during the preceding six months.
- 3. Need based assistance, which may be considered on case to case basis to a 'recognized Startup entity' towards cost of raw material / components / Research & Development and other related equipments required for the innovative process for new product development / existing product improvement.

However, this assistance will be provided only in case(s) where innovation is dependent on specific raw material / equipment / Research & Development and subject to approval by the Startup Council.

4. Financial Support to Startups for participating in National and International Events:

- a. The government shall provide financial support to State recognized Startups for participating in the reputed National & International events, where they are representing the State.
- b. The support may include economy class airfare or 3 tier AC train fare for travel and free space in the stall if set up by State Government.
- 5. Subsidized Incubation:Recognised Startups may avail subsidy benefit to the extent of 50% of monthly rental of the incubation space (subject to a maximum of Rs.5000/-) for a period of maximum one year, if getting incubated at any of the incubators recognised by the Startup Odisha Initiative.

Application Process for availing Financial Benefit

- 1. Once recognized, a startup entity can apply online for the monetary benefit with Startup Odisha initiative by filling a standard form (Annexure-3).
- 2. The Nodal Agency will review the monetary application of the startup entity and will share its review online with the Startup Secretariat within next 2 weeks of receipt of such application. However, Nodal Agency may schedule a call or a meeting with the startup entity, if it deems necessary, within the first week of receipt of such application.
- 3. Startup Secretariat will collate all such applications and undertake due diligence of the applications and requisite documents (Annexures 3-5) and present them with its recommendation to the Task Force for consideration and final approval within next 2 weeks of receipt of such application. Result will be published online and also emailed to the concerned Startup entity.
- Once approved by the Task Force, Startup will receive the monetary benefit(s) directly in the entity's bank account.
- 5. In case of application by a recognised Startup for financial support to participate in reputed National & International events, the Nodal agency will review the application(s), verify documents and forward its recommendation to the Startup Secretariat within one week of submission of such application(s).

The Startup Secretariat will then, examine such recommendations received from nodal agencies and furnish its final recommendation to the Task Force to enable it to take decision. The Task Force may accept or reject the recommendation.

Once approved, the Startup will get reimbursement of economy class air fare subject to a maximum of Rs. 8,000/-for domestic travel or Rs. 20,000/- for international travel limited to actuals or 3-tier a/c train fare for travel (to and fro) to the city of event.

6. For Subsidized Incubation, a recognised Startup may apply in the application form prescribed at Annexure-12. Once applied, the application will go to the concerned recognised Incubator opted by the Startup.

The Incubator concerned will examine the application and may accept or reject the application by giving reasons therefore. In case the incubator concerned is recommending the acceptance of the application, it will indicate the monthly rental of Incubation Space to the Startup Secretariat within one week of receiving the application.

Startup Secretariat then may accept or reject the recommendation of the incubator. In case it agrees, may reimburse 50% of the monthly rental of the incubation space subject to maximum of Rs. 5,000/- per month for a maximum period of one year. The reimbursement will directly be made to

the concerned recognised incubator subject to submission of monthly bill and certificate of occupancy of the Startup duly certified by both the concerned incubator and Startup.

7. In case a Nodal Agency is unable to evaluate an application within the specified time of 2 weeks (1 week in case of applications financial support to participate in reputed National & International events), it shall be granted a maximum of additional 1week time to complete the process. In case the concerned Nodal Agency does not meet the extended deadline, the application shall automatically move to another Nodal agency with the same domain with the time limit of two weeks (1 week in case of applications financial support to participate in reputed National & International events) for disposal. In rare cases, where both the first and the second Nodal Agency fail to evaluate an application within their specified time limits, it shall automatically move to the Startup Secretariat. The Startup Secretariat shall evaluate the same within two weeks.

Fund Release Guideline

1. Monthly Allowance:

- a. Monthly payment for the first three months may be made directly to a recognized eligible startup entity in its registered bank account on a monthly basis.
- b. Three months onwards, payment may be released based on the utilization report submitted by the

- Startup online to the Nodal agency within 15 days of completion of the first three months.
- c. Startup entity shall submit a utilization report highlighting the utilization of the monthly allowance in the first three months and enclose/upload supporting documents and bills, where applicable.
- d. Payment of the monthly allowance will be made for a period of one year only.
- e. Startup entity can avail this benefit only once.
- f. Startup entity shall submit a final utilization certificate highlighting utilization of the monthly allowance along with supporting documents and bills within one month of the completion of 1 year.

2. Product Development and Marketing / Publicity Assistance:

- a. Startup will have to submit a selfcontained product development plan with justification, online (Annexure-4).
- b. Subject to approval, 50% of the payment to a recognized startup entity may be made in advance and the remaining 50% will be made to its registered bank account upon utilization of the advance payment on the basis of submission of utilization certificate along with bills.
- c. The Startup entity must submit utilization certificate along with bills for the advance payment within three months of receiving the grant.
- d. The Startup entity must submit final utilization certificate along with bills for the entire amount within six months of release of grant.

3. Need based Assistance:

- a. Startup entity will have to submit a self-contained plan with justification online (Annexure-5) for the need and the manner of utilisation of the assistance.
- b. Subject to approval, payment may be made directly to a recognized startup in its registered bank account.
- c. The Startup entity must submit utilization certificate along with bills for all the expenses within three months of receiving the grant.

4. Financial Support for participating in reputed National and International Events:

- a. The Startup entity will apply online (Form at Annexure 11) along with required supporting document for financial support to cover travel expenses for participating in reputed National/International event.
- b. Subject to approval, payment may be made directly to a recognised Startup in its registered bank account.

5. Subsidized Incubation:

- a. The startup entity will have to apply online (Annexure 12) for subsidized incubation at any of the Incubators recognised by Startup Odisha Initiative.
- b. Once approved, a fresh rent agreement needs to be made between the Startup and the Incubator based on the subsidized incubation approval for one year

- and the same be submitted to Startup Secretariat within 1 month from approval date.
- c. The reimbursement will directly be made to the concerned recognised incubator on quarterly basis based on submission of bill and certificate of occupancy of the Startup duly certified by both the concerned incubator and Startup.
- d. Payment of the monthly subsidy will be made for a period of one year only.
- e. This benefit can be availed only once by a recognised Startup.
- f. Startup cannot sub-lease or share subsidized incubation space with any other entity during the subsidy period.

III - Incubator

Benefits to Incubators

- 1. One-Time Capital Grant of 50% of the capital cost (excluding the cost of building) up to a maximum of Rs.1 crore, which may be given to an approved incubator to set up or scale up incubation facility.
- 2. In case, a university recognised under the Central/ State Act/ a reputed academic institution/ Centre of Excellence such as IIT, IIM, NISER, IISER etc. is able to raise funding for development of its incubation infrastructure, the Startup Council may consider providing a matching grant subject to an upper limit of Rs.5 crore on

- case-to-case basis. Such grant from the government shall only be used for development of incubation infrastructure including purchase of equipment for the incubation facility.
- 3. Reimbursement of Utility Expenses of Rs.1 lakh per year for a period of 3 years, which may be provided to an approved incubator for providing free internet, free electricity and free mentoring services to the incubatees. This benefit will not be available to virtual incubators.
- 4. Performance capital grant of Rs.5 lakhs, which may be given to an approved incubator for its each successful Startup incubated at least for a minimum period of 3 months.

Application Process for Approval (Recognition) of an Incubator

- 1. Existing / Aspiring incubator may register by filling Incubator Registration Form with Startup Odisha initiative (Annexure-6).
- 2. Startup Secretariat will collate all such applications and will present them with its recommendation to the Task Force for final consideration and approval.
- 3. Task force will consider these applications once in a month and decide.
- 4. Result will be published online and also emailed to the concerned Incubator.

Application Process for availing Monetary Benefit

- 1. An approved incubator may apply online for monetary benefit as applicable, with Startup Odisha initiative (Annexure-7).
- 2. Incubator shall provide proof of capital investment made as 'own contribution' for availing one-time capital grant.
- 3. In case a university is able to raise funding for development of its incubation facility, proof of such funding shall be provided for availing the matching grant.
- 4. Startup Secretariat will collate all such applications, undertake due diligence of such applications and requisite documents and will present them with its recommendation to the Task Force / Startup Council for final consideration and approval. Result will be published online and also emailed to the concerned incubator.
- 5. Once approved by the Task Force / Startup Council, the existing / aspiring incubator will receive the monetary benefit directly in its bank account.

Eligibility

1. One-Time Capital Grant:

a. Aspiring / Existing incubators established in a University / Educational Institute will be eligible for one time grant of 50% of capital cost (excluding the cost of building) up to a maximum of Rs. 1.0 crore to set up / scale up an Incubator Facility.

- b. However, Aspiring / Existing incubator should dedicate a minimum of 5,000 sq. feet of carpet area to the incubatees.
- c. In case, a university recognised under the Central/State Act/ a reputed academic institution/ Centre of Excellence such as IIT, IIM, NISER, IISER etc. is able to raise funding for development of its incubation infrastructure, the Startup Council may consider providing a matching grant subject to an upper limit of Rs.5 crore on case-to-case basis.
- d. Such grant from the govt. shall only be used for development of incubator infrastructure including purchase of equipment for the incubation facility.

2. Reimbursement of utility Expenses:

- a. Applying body should be an approved Incubator.
- b. Applicable only for an incubator having physical infrastructure in place.
- c. Applicable only if incubator is providing free internet, free electricity and free mentoring services to the incubatees.

3. Performance capital grant

- a. Applying body should be an existing approved Incubator.
- b. Applicable, only if the successful startup is incubated for at least three months at the approved incubator.

Fund Release Guideline

1. One-Time Capital Grant:

- a. The approved aspiring/ existing incubator will submit online application for Monetary Grant (Annexure-7) to the Startup Secretariat and upload requisite documents for due diligence.
- b. The grant may be disbursed in a phased manner as per the budget/ utilisation plan submitted by the incubator and approved by the Startup Council.
- c. The grant may be disbursed in proportion to the funds brought in by the approved incubator, as mentioned in their budget plan and approved by the Startup Council.

2. Reimbursement of Utility Expense:

- a. One-time payment of utility expenses limiting to Rs. 1 lakh per year for a maximum period of 3 years may be made directly to the approved existing incubator in its registered bank account.
- b. The incubator must submit bills for the expenses while availing the grant and submit utilization certificate within 3 months of the release of the grant.

3. Performance capital Grant:

- a. One-time payment may be made directly to the approved incubator in its registered bank account.
- b. The approved incubator will submit a

list of the successful incubatees incubated at least for a period of three months.

IV - Nodal Agency

Introduction

In order to avail the benefits announced in the Startup Odisha initiative, an entity would be required to be recognised as a Startup. To this effect, it would be required to submit an application online along with a note on innovation. All such registering entities application's need to be carefully reviewed by an expert committee hosted under the Nodal Agency. As per the policy "Nodal Agency shall mean reputed Government as well as other institutions/ organizations as approved by the Startup Council as Nodal Agencies for certifying Startups."

Objective

To review

- (i) Applications of Startups for their recognition and
- (ii) The merit of the Startup applications for monetary grants.

Fee

Nodal Agency will be paid fee for review of registration & all other assistance as follows:

- Startup Recognition: One-time fee of Rs. 1,500 per application
- Monetary Grant Application: One-time fee of Rs. 5,000 per application, which shall also include the periodic review of startups' performance.

Fund release guideline

The bill for the fee payable to the nodal agency will be auto generated by the system on a monthly basis and will be paid after due diligence by the Startup Secretariat directly in the Bank A/c of the Nodal Agency.

Selection of the Nodal Agency

Selection of Nodal Agency will be on invitation basis only with the approval of Startup Council. The selected Nodal Agency will however have to fill up a form as per Annexure-8.

V - Application for Registering as Angel Network

Introduction

In order to register or avail monetary benefits under the Startup Odisha initiative, one of the selection criteria is being funded through an angel network recognised by Startup Odisha initiative.

Selection of Angel Network

For an angel network entity to register with Startup Odisha, it would be required to submit an application online (Annexure-9) and will have to submit following documents:

- 1) Incorporation Structure.
- 2) Investment facilitation declaration duly certified by a registered Chartered Accountant/statutory auditor authorizing the funding.

All such applications need to be carefully reviewed by the Startup Secretariat and will be approved by the Startup Council. Result will be emailed to Angel Network directly and will also be published online.



VI - Terms & Conditions

- 1. The incubator will be required to put in place the requisite physical infrastructure (shared/specific) such as laboratory, workshop facilities, utilities, support services, preincubation services, networking, mentoring and other facilities within a period of six months from the date of release of capital grant and other benefits.
- 2. The incubator would also put in place a dedicated full time Chief Executive Officer (CEO) with desired domain and management expertise with other core team/supporting staff for the successful operation of incubator within two months from the date of release of funds.
- 3. The incubator would evolve a transparent system for selection of incubatees. The incubatees would be admitted subject to fulfilling the admission criteria and the incubator would enter into an appropriate agreement with its incubatees.
- 4. Each incubator would be required to have a website of its own, which should be updated on a continuous basis.
- 5. The grantee is required to send online i) progress report; and ii) audited statement of accounts and Balance Sheets to the Startup Secretariat at the end of each financial year as well as at the time of seeking further installments of the grant, if any. However, companies and individuals would be required to submit a yearly expenditure statement for the full amount (including their own contribution) to ensure that matching funding is released.

- 6. The incubator will be reviewed quarterly both for financial and physical performance. The release of subsequent grants will be based on satisfactory performance.
- 7. Officers of the Startup Secretariat/
 Government may visit the organization periodically for ascertaining the progress of work and resolving any difficulties that might be encountered during the course of implementation.
- 8. Government/Startups Secretariat reserves the right to terminate support to the incubator at any stage, if it is convinced that the grant is not being utilized properly for the purpose for which the same is released.
- 9. All the assets acquired or created from the grant will be entered and maintained in a separate register and should not be disposed-off or encumbered or utilized for purpose other than those for which the grant has been sanctioned without the prior permission of the Startup Secretariat.
- 10. The grantee must not entrust the implementation of the work for which the grant is being sanctioned to another institution and divert the grant receipts as assistance to the latter institution.
- 11. In case any information provided is found to be false, the Startup / Incubator's registration will stand canceled and it will have to repay the assistance already released within six months failing which action will be initiated as per Government rules and guidelines for recovery.
